THE NEW TOWN AT ST. CHARLES GENERAL ASSEMBLY

Rule 4.14 in The New Town at St. Charles Rules and Regulations regulates signage in New Town. It specifically limits "for sale" signs. The New Town at St. Charles General Assembly has real estate signs available for use. The following fees apply:

\$100.00 Deposit (Refunded when sign is returned in original order)

\$30.00 for use up to three months (Reserve period)

\$10.00 per month after the initial three month period (Additional reserve period)

*** (There are no partial refunds for early returns) ***

The initial three-month fee and this deposit shall be paid at the time the sign is picked up from the General Assembly. Any monthly extensions (Additional Reserve Periods) shall be paid prior to the expiration of any reserve period that has been previously purchased. If the fee for any extension (Additional reserve period) is not paid and received in the General Assembly Office by the return date, the General Assembly Office will charge a late fee of \$10.00 per week. In addition to the late fee, if the extension fee is still unpaid two months after the fee is due or the payment is tendered late on more then two occasions, then the General Assembly Office has the authority to remove the sign from the property.

If the sign is removed by the General Assembly office due to more than two late extension payments or because a fee is over sixty days past due, the \$100.00 deposit will not be refunded.

The deposit will be refunded when the real estate sign is returned to The New Town at St. Charles General Assembly, assuming that there is no damage to the sign. The sign must be cleaned off at the base, and not have any mud or dirt attached to the bottom. All pieces of the real estate signs must be returned. If any of these pieces are not returned with the sign or are returned damaged, the following charges will be deducted from the deposit:

\$10.00	Sold Sign
\$10.00	Open House
\$20.00	Brochure Holder
\$50.00	Broken or cracked Home for Sale sign
\$20.00	4 x 4 post
\$5.00	2 bolts

Please be aware that prior to the distribution of any sign by The New Town at St. Charles General Assembly, homeowners or real estate agents must call *Missouri One Call at 1-800-344-7483* to find out where utility lines are run for proper sign location.

Homeowners or real estate agents are responsible for the sign's installation. Installations should not deviate from the approved plot plan and all signs should be installed with the wood stake buried two feet in the ground with four feet showing above ground.
